Essential Things and Guidelines for Amarnath Yatra

The **Amarnath Yatra** is one of the most revered pilgrimages for devotees of Lord Shiva. Each year, lakhs of yatris from across India and abroad embark on this sacred journey to seek blessings at the **Amarnath Cave**, where the naturally formed ice lingam is worshipped as a divine manifestation of Lord Shiva. If you are planning to undertake the **Amarnath Yatra 2026**, this complete guide will provide you with all the essential information – from registration and routes to facilities, accommodation, and important tips.

Amarnath Yatra 2026 Dates

The **Shri Amarnathji Shrine Board (SASB)** will officially announce the yatra dates for 2026. Traditionally, the yatra begins in **late June** and concludes on **Shravan Purnima (Raksha Bandhan)** in **August**. Pilgrims must plan their journey in accordance with these dates.

- Yatra Open Dates 01 Jul 2026 (Tentative)
- Yatra Closed Dates 28 Aug 2026 (Raksha Bandhan)
- Medical Process Open Dates On or after 07 April 2026
- Registration process Open Dates On or after 17th April 2026

All the above final dates will announce by Shri Amarnathji Shrine Board Official only.

Accommodation and Facilities

- Tent accommodations and huts at key halting points.- Tented accommodation on rental basis is available at various Yatra camps like Panchtarni, Sheshnag, Nunwan, Baltal etc. enroute to the Holy Cave Shrine.
- Langars (free community kitchens) offering meals and refreshments-

Various societies / NGOs offer food, drinking water, refreshments etc. free of cost to the pilgrims at various locations along both Yatra routes enroute the Holy Cave Shrine during Yatra period.

- Medical aid centers and oxygen facilities for emergencies.- Health and Medical Education Department, J&K with the assistance of various NGO's, Army and CAPF's sets up various health care facilities like base hospitals, medical / emergency aid centres, oxygen booths, ambulatory services etc. at various location enroute to Holy Cave Shrine during the yatra.
- Cloakrooms and security arrangements The facility of cloak room is made available to the pilgrims at various camps/ Holy Cave during the Yatra Period.
- Parking Facility Parking facility for two wheelers, LMVs, HMVs is available at Baltal on rental basis
- **Telecom Services** Network connectivity in Yatra area is provided by BSNL, JIO & AIRTEL. Pre-paid or Pre-on Post Sim cards can be purchased at various locations including base camps.
- Pony /Pithu /Palki Facility of ponies/pithus/palkiwala can be availed on rental basis at various yatra camps / digital prepaid counters enroute to the Holy Cave Shrine

Packing Essentials for Yatris

- Warm clothing, woolens, and raincoats. Sturdy trekking shoes.
- Please keep your clothes and eatables in a suitable water proof bag to avoid your belongings getting wet.
- Walking stick, gloves, and torch light.
- Women Yatris should avoid wearing Saree during trekking and should wear Salwar Kameez, Pant-Shirt, Track suit or any recommended clothing suited for trekking on high altitude.
- Basic medicines and a first aid kit.
- Please consult your doctor and get your health check-up done before

• ID proof, Yatra Permit, and health certificate.

Important Guidelines

- Only healthy pilgrims between 13 and 70 years with valid CHC are permitted.
- Pregnant women (more than 6 weeks) are not allowed.
- Follow eco-friendly practices do not litter in the Himalayas.
- Respect local traditions and maintain discipline during the yatra.
- The Yatri Must Wear the RFID Card Around His/her Neck during the entire duration of Yatra
- Every Yatri must carry RFID Card
- Please walk 4-5 Km daily, consult your doctor, exercise deep breathing and drink plenty of water etc. to prepare yourself for the Yatra.
- Please walk slowly while ascending, relax at regular intervals and descend immediately to lower elevation in case of any symptom of sickness, discomfort during the Yatra and seek nearby Medical Help.
- Please do not commence journey on an empty stomach. Please do not overexert during the Yatra beyond your normal capacity.
- During Yatra, please travel in groups with porters/horses/ponies and ensure they remain in your sight. Please help your fellow Yatris on the tracks.
- Please do not attempt any shortcuts, walk only on the track and never stop at places which are marked by warning notice.
- Free food facility is available in the entire Yatra area at the langars. Please consume plenty of carbohydrates and follow prescribed food menu.
- The Holy Cave is located at around12800 feet, please do take precautions in view of high-altitude sickness and avoid overnight stay at Holy Cave.
 Please do not ignore the symptoms of high-altitude sickness.

- Please perform Yatra with a pious mind and do not throw coins, notes, chunni etc. at the Holy Lingam.
- In case of emergency, please contact nearest Camp Director/ MRT or Control Room.
